<u>Candidates will be considered for admission only if they</u> satisfy all the conditions given below:

a) They must have completed all courses of all sections/parts of the examination within 5 years and should have secured a minimum of 60% marks on aggregate in each section/part.

 b) They should be admitted only through CEPA or through an equivalent examination.

c) The admission of such candidates will be initially confined to their parent disciplines.
