With reference to your letter No. BCT/158 dated 19.7.1973, I am directed to inform you that Executive Council has at its meeting held in 27th June 1973 decided on the recommendation of the standing Committee of the engineering faculty that the A.M.I.E. candidates desirous of seeking admission to M.E. courses of the University should be enabled to do so by appearing at an entrance examination equivalent to final year B.E. The admission will be made in order of merit by comparing the marks obtained by them in theory papers with pass-outs of the B.E. Examination.

ITEM No. 4.
