Sir,

Sub: Admission of Candidates who have passed the AMIE for Post-graduate Courses.

I write to state that the issue was considered by the Board of Studies in Engineering and the Faculty of Engineering at their meetings held on 13th and 14th December 1972, respectively. The Faculty of Engg. RESOLVED that a candidate who has passed Sections A & B Examinations of The Institution of Engineers (India) be permitted to seek admission in the Post-graduate studies in the University, provided he passes an entrance examination conducted by the Institution where Postgraduate courses are run with 55% of marks.

The above recommendation was considered by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 30.12.1972 and the Academic Council after due consideration has accepted the same.

I therefore request that the applications of candidates who have passed the AMIE (Sections A & B) examination be considered for admission to Post-graduate Engineering Courses in your College provided they pass the entrance examination conducted by you and secures 55% marks.
