PROFESSIONAL QUALIFICATIONS, MINISTRY OF EDUCATION,
PASSING THE A.M.I.E. EXAMINATIONS
AS EQUIVALENT TO A DEGREE IN ENGINEERING

The Revised Scheme of Examinations provided for candidates to qualify in specific branches of Engineering viz. Civil, Mechanical, Electrical, Metallurgical, Mining, Chemical and Electrical Communications. Since the examinations of the Institution of Engineers (India) are already recognised by the Central Government, the recognition will ipso facto apply to the revised scheme as well, not only to Civil, Mechanical and Electrical branches but also to Chemical, Metallurgical, Mining and Electronics and Communications Engineering.
