- (c) The upper age limit prescribed above will be further relaxable—
- Upto a maximum of five years if a candidate belongs to a Scheduled Caste or a Scheduled Tribo;
- (ii) Upto a maximum of three years in the case of condidates belonging to Other Backward Classes who are eligible to swall of reservation applicable to such candidates. - extended beyond five years and in whose case the Ministry of Defence issues a certificate that they can apply for old lamplayment and they will be released on three months notice on selection from the date of neceipt of other of appunitment;

NOTE (I)—Candidates belonging to the Scheduled Cases and the Scheduled Tribes and the Other Beckward Clesses who are also covered under anyother clauses of Para 3 (II)(c) above, viz those coming under he category of Exisendement, persons demiciled in the State of J & K deaf-mule and orthopaedically handicapead above the eligible for grant of cumulative age relaxation under both the categories.

NOTE (II)—The term ex-servicemen will apply to the persons who are defined as ex-servicemen (Re-employment in Civil Services and Posts) Rules, 1979, as amended from time to time.

NOTE (III)—The age concession under Para S(II) (c)(v) and (vi) will not be edmissible to Ex-Servicemen and Commissioned Officers including ECOs/SSCOs, who are released on their own request.

NOTE (IV) Notwithstanding, the provision of age relaxation under Para 3(1) (c)(vii) shows, a physically hemiciaspped carefulate will be considered to be eligible for appointment only if he/she (after such physical estantisation as the Government or appointing authority, as the case may be, may presentible) is found to satisfy the requirement of physical and medical standards for the concerned Services-Posts to be allosted to the physically handicapped candidates by the Government.

NOTE (V)—A candidate will be eligible to get the benefit of community reservation only in case the particular caste to which the candidates belong is included in the list of reserved communities issued by the Central Government. If a candidate indicates in his-her application form for Engineering Services Examination that he/she belongs to General category but subsequently writes to the Commission to change his/her category to a reserved one, such request shell not be entertained by the Commission.

"Candidates seeking reservation/relaxation benefits available for SC/ST/OBC/PH/Ex-Servicemen must ensure that they are entitled to such reservation/relaxation as per eligibility prescribed in the Rules/Notice. While the above principle will be followed in general, there may be a few cases where there was a little gap (say 2-3 months) between the issuance of a Constitution of the community in the list of any of the reserved communities and the date of submission of the application by the candidate. In such cases the request of change of community from General to Reserved may be considered by the Commission on merit.

N.B.—The candicature of a person who is admitted to the examination under the age concession mentioned in Para 3(1)(b) above shall be cancelled if, after submitting his application heighte resigns from service or his services are terminated by his/her department/office-either before or after taking the examination. Heache will, however, continue to be eligible if height is retranched from the service or post after submitting his application. SAVE AS PROVIDED ABOVE THE AGE LIMITS PRESCRIBED CAN IN NO CASE BE RELAXED.

The date of birth accepted by the Commission is that entered in the Matriculation or Secondary School Leaving Certificate or in a certificate recognised an Indian University as equivalent to Matriculation or in an extractifrom a Register of matriculates maintained by a University, and that extract must be pertified by the proper authority of the University or in the Higher Secondary or an equivalent exemination conflicate. Those conflicates are required to be submitted along with the Detailed Application Forms which will be required to be submitted by the candidates who qualify on the result of the written part of the examination.

No other document relating to age like horoscopes, affidavits, birth extracts from Municipa Corporation, service records and the like will be accepted.

The expression Matriculation/Secondary Examination Certificate in this part of the instruction includes the alternative certificates mentioned above.

NOTE 1: CANDIDATES SHOULD NOTE THAT ONLY THE DATE OF BIRTH AS RECORDED IN THE MATRICULATION/SECONDARY EXAMINATION CERTIFICATE OR AN EQUIVALENT CERTIFICATE ON THE DATE OF SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION WILL BE ACCEPTED BY THE COMMISSION AND NO SUBSEQUENT REQUEST FOR ITS CHANGE WILL BE CONSIDERED OR GRANTED.

NOTE 2: CANDIDATES SHOULD ALSO NOTE THAT ONCE A DATE OF DIRTHHAS BEEN CLAIMED BY THEM AND ENTERED IN THE RECORDS OF THE COMMISSION FOR THE FURROSE OF ADMISSION TO AN EXAMINATION NO CHANGE WILL BE ALLOWED SUBSECUENTLY OR AT ANY OTHER EXAMINATION OF THE COMMISSION, ON ANY GROUNDS WILATSOCYCE.

NOTE 3: CANDIDATES SHOULD EXERCISE DUE CARE WHILE ENTERING THEIR DATE OF BIRTH IN THE RESPECTIVE COLUMN OF THE APPLICATION FORM. IF ON VERIFICATION AT ANY SUBSEQUENT STAGE, ANY VARIATION IS FOUND IN THEIR DATE OF BIRTH FROM THE ONE ENTERED IN THEIR MATRICULATION OR EQUIVALENT EXAMINATION CERTIFICATE, DISCIPLINARY ACTION WILL BE TAKEN AGAINST THEM BY THE COMMISSION UNDER THE RULES.

(III) Minimum Educational Qualification: For admission to the examination, a candidate must have—

- (a) obtained a degree in Engineering from a University incorporated by an Act of the Central or State Legislature in inde or other Educational Institutions established by an Act of Parliament or declared to be deemed as University established by an Act of Parliament or declared section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956; or
- passed Sections A and B of the Institution Examinations of the Institution of Engineers (India); or
- obtained a degree/diplome in Enginoeing from such foreign University/ Callege/institution and under such conditions as may be recognised by the Government for the purpose from time to time, or
- passed Graduate Membership Exemination of the Institute of Electronics and Telecommunication Engineers (India); or
- passed Associate Membership Examination Parts II and III/Sections A and B of the Aeronautical Society of India; or
- passed Graduate Membership Examination of the Institution of Electronics and Radio Engineers, London held after November, 1969.

Provided that a candidate for the post of Indian Nazel Armaniant Service (Bectronica Eigheering Posts) and Engineer, Or, Win Indian Radio Regulatory Service-Gr. 'A may possess any of the above qualifications or the qualification mentioned below namely-

M.Sc. degree or its equivalent with Wineless Communication. Beschancs, Radio Physics or Radio Engineering as a special subject.

NDTE-1—A candidate who has appeared at an examination the passing of which would render him educationally qualified for this examination, but has not been informed of the result, may apply for admission to the examination.
