Sub: Recognition of passing of Sections A & B of AMIE as equivalent to B.E. Degree - Provision of incentives to employees

Dear Sir,

Kindly refer to your letter Mo. GC/2646 dated 26.4.1976 addressed to the Director General, All India Radio, New Delhi, and letter No. GC/3243 dated 5.7.1976 addressed to the Chief Engineer, All India Radio, New Delhi. It may be stated that passing Sections A & B of A.M.I.E. India is a recognised qualification considered equivalent to an Engineering Degree in A.I.R. also. We do not give any advance increments to persons passing either the Institution of Engineers (India) examination or the examination held by the Institution of Electronics and Telecommunication Engineers. However, persons passing the examination and working in subordinate posts are eligible to appear in the combined Engineering Services Examination held by U.P.S.C. for recruitment to higher posts, provided they are within the prescribed age limits. Special incentive is given to these persons by considering them for promotion to the gazetted cadre of Asstt. Engineer against the departmental quota allotted to us after two years of their passing the examination. A number of our employees have been benefitted by these provisions in the staff regulations.
